

## AMOS RAJAMONEY EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The programme is initiated for orphan/semi-orphan/vulnerable children from the community who could not afford their basic education. These children are admitted in private schools, to complete their education and also providing essentials such as fees, books, copies, bag, clothes, and etc. and support the children till they complete the Schooling and also support them to complete their professional studies and help them in mainstreaming them back to the Society.



## AMOS RAJAMONEY SOCIO- LEGAL SERVICES TO THE VULNERABLE PRISONERS

This programme runs for the inmates of the prison who are vulnerable or poor that could not afford their bail as being uneducated of their rights as they are not involved in committing of the crime but eventually land in prison houses. Asha Deep Foundation is trying to provide legal Aids to the vulnerable inmates of the prisoners with the support of Advocates.



## AASHIYANA – A HOME FOR CHILDREN SUFFERING FROM CANCER

Children who are suffering from cancer, who are poor or come from a vulnerable family and the treatment of cancer requires repeated consultations and follow-up of the case. As these children and their families come from very far-off places, they do not get a place to stay and have to sleep under open sky. The programme helps in providing shelter to the affected during course of their treatment and deals in provision of shelter, nutrition, education, recreational and medical care enabling child-friendly and nurturing environment for children needing rehabilitation.



## COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES (CDP)

The Community Development Programme is for the welfare of the people impacted by the COVID-19. The main focus are rag-pickers and migrants' communities working for their holistic development in terms of education, healthcare and awareness, skill development, livelihood opportunities, capacity building and rights awareness. The project aims to ensure their social upbringing, development of self-dignity and access to fundamental civil rights to secure them a place in mainstream society.



## REHABILITATING A VICTIM COMMUNITY OF UNSAFE MIGRATION FROM THE DEVASTATING CONSEQUENCES OF COVID 19

This is an issue-based project mainly focused on migrant workers displaced due to the impact of COVID-19 restrictions. We aim to assist victimized communities to be safely migrated, gain their human and occupational dignity along with leading a sustainable life in the place of destination with an acceptable socio-economic standard.



## HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING CENTER (HRD)

HRD is the vital force behind all area programs and activities. HRD works with project managers and supervisors to create and implement structure programs and activities that send to the needs of the underprivileged. HRD conducts frequent seminars workshops and staff training sessions for capacity building and upgrading of skills and knowledge of staff members and community people. Additionally, HRD coordinates monitoring and evaluation of all activities to ensure ADF continuous to make a positive and constructive impact on society.



## SPORTS FOR DEVELOPMENT

Sports for development the main purpose of the program is to empower children and youth with positive experiences to enable them to discover and develop true sport. The goal of the project includes sensitizing and advocating the child's rights to play, promoting gender equality, developing personal and social skills and bringing communities together through sporting opportunities by giving exposure to excellence and fair play.



## SKILL TRAINING AND PLACEMENT OF YOUTHS WITH AND WITHOUT DISABILITIES

The programme deals with implementing comprehensive training programmes among both disabled and normal youth where PWDs youth will be supported through home based approach and also institutional based by providing career opportunities, job offers and soft skills for the development of the PWD's and normal youth through institutionalizing an effective Quality Assurance System by benchmarking to international best practices and new educational technology based pedagogies.



## SKILL TRAINING TO GOVT. SCHOOL STUDENTS

The programme empowers adolescents of Government schools students by building self awareness and coping skills, cultivating compassion and hope leading to enhanced wellbeing and motivation to learn. The focus of the programme is to help children understand the physical, emotional and psychological development of the adolescent stage in the age group of 12-15 years enabling them to express and regulate their emotions and enjoy learning as a process.



## REMEDIAL CLASSES FOR THE UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN

The programme ensures basic right to education and enhances the quality of life in the community of rag pickers/ vulnerable/ underprivileged children through basic education, health care and development facilities by enrolling children attaining 5 years to formal schools through regular follow-up. The children who are school drop outs are identified and extra support as Remedial classes are provided through monitoring and assessment.



## GENERAL DUTY ASSISTANT(GDA)

The general duty assistant programme is a 3-month course ( Health Care and Core Employability). It trains the enrolled students in providing immediate care to a patient and to assist doctors and nurses in their work. The primary aim is to provide economic empowerment and opportunities to the youth of underprivileged communities through healthcare training.



## SOFT SKILLS TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR GOVT. SCHOOL STUDENTS

Asha Deep Foundation providing Soft skill training for the Government school students of Tamil Nadu. The soft skills training sessions are conducted through PPT, videos with small stories, activities like games etc. It is done completely in a participatory method and the School Students gets the opportunity to develop their skills.



## CONCLUSION

The organisation is persistently working from its inception for holistic development of the community, addressing issues and problems of all age groups from pre-natal care to quality life of senior citizens. Therefore, Asha Deep Foundation is a "Womb to Tomb" organization. It has been working tirelessly since last four decades for uplifting people. ### Introduction

Asha Deep Foundation is a National level voluntary organization – PAN India, has been working for the development of the underprivileged communities since its inception in 1983, covering more than 5 million populations by implementing different Social Welfare Projects. Our main thematic areas are Education, Health, Livelihood, Child in need of Care & Protection and Residential. The organization works towards holistic development with all the target groups like children, Youth, Women and Senior Citizen.



### Vision Statement

To help people realize their potentialities and create their own destiny and make them self reliant and independent, realizing their human dignity, self respect and freedom.

### Mission Statement

Asha Deep literally translates to “Hope and Light”. Asha Deep strives to be the Hope and Light amongst the deprived and underprivileged community to inspire and motivate them to realize their human dignity, develop a capacity to solve their own problems and to lift themselves out of poverty. The organisation works for the social and economical development of the people by providing whatever practical help they need in the form of information, advice, capacity building, training, and support.

### Our Thematic Areas



### CHILDREN EDUCATION :

**EDUCATION BRINGS REVOLUTIONARY CHANGES IN THE LIVES OF THE UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN"**

St. James Convent School for the underprivileged children (St.JCS) provides education to over 1000 students. The aim is to develop children at all levels. This is done through organizing different activities in the School like : Art & Craft, Exhibition, Sports and Games, Picnic and Outings, Inter school competition, scouts and guides etc. The Pre School maintain a child friendly environment and incorporated play – way teaching methods. Regular parents meetings are organized in the school.

Four Houses are formed in the school – Gandhi, Tagore, Vivekananda and Nehru House. The students take full responsibility and leadership in organizing various events in the school. Extra classes and attention are given to the students who are academically below average to raise their level of understanding.



### CHILDLINE - GHAZIABAD & MODI NAGAR

Childline is a 24-hour phone service linking children in need of care and protection to a network of organization working on behalf of children throughout India. Childline Ghaziabad and Modi Nagar handles thousands of cases involving child labour, abandonment, missing children, guidance and counseling, rescue, repatriation, medical and shelter. It raise awareness about child rights and the support service available when calling the children number 1098.



### CHILD EDUCATION CENTER (CEC)

For the children between 2 to 4 years belonging to rag picking families and other underprivileged communities are provided play way teaching, health care, nutrition etc. Once the child attains the age of 5 years, the assistance of getting an admission in the nearest government school is provided by networking with Government schools of the society. After they get the admission, a proper follow up is done with the school constantly about the child who is admitted. This programme ensures the holistic development of the child.



### REHABILITATION CENTER FOR ORPHAN/ VULNERABLE YOUTH

This programme provides shelter to the youth above 18 years of age. Youth enrolled are involved in all-round development and recreational activities provided under a positive environment where they can acquire new skilled based courses. Orientation and training sessions are provided on personality development along with the techniques to face an interview. Once they are able to find a suitable job and become independent they are rehabilitated back to the society.



### ASHA INTEGRATED PROGRAMME FOR SENIOR CITIZEN

The elderly in India suffer a great deal, physically and emotionally. Senior citizens ultimately are isolated from their families and have a deep sense of loneliness. ADF operates different centers to accommodate the elderly. At the center, they receive a meal, counseling and health care. Most importantly, the center allow them to sing, dance, talk, and enjoy the company of other people.



### ASHA DEVELOPMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTER FOR DIFFERENTLY ABLED

Since the inception in 1983, Asha Deep Foundation is working towards helping differently able children and adults where the holistic development of children including childcare, education and health are provided and adults who are differently able are helped in being self-sustained through skill training and provision of different need-based support.



Food assistance is provided to these people for the temporary relief from starvation. Assistance to the differently able people in applying and getting the Physical disability certificate is also provided.

### ASHA VOCATIONAL & TECHINCAL TRAINING INSTITUTE (AVTTI)

AVTTI provides economic development for the underprivileged youth by offering courses in diverse fields like ; Computer Software and Hardware, Cutting and Tailoring, Beauty Culture, Fashion Designing, Spoken English, Zari Zardozi and many of their job oriented courses. Learners are awarded certificates, AVTTI graduates gain employment in different sectors or become self- entrepreneurs, improving the economic standing for themselves and their families.



### ASHA SKILL INSTITUTE FOR GIRLS/WOMEN

The programme provides qualitative training in skill trade to the underprivileged girls and women in developing their skill so they can easily be able to sustain and be self reliant in their future. The disadvantage groups of beneficiaries are trained in cutting and tailoring and fashion designing which increases employability opportunities for them further developing entrepreneurship and business skills among the youth that they may start their own venture and business in future.



The duration of the programme is 6 months where the classes are provided to the girls and women from the age of 18 to 35 years.

### EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION (GALI PRE SCHOOL)

The Early Childhood Education Programme prepares children for formal school while developing their parents interest in theory education. Gali Pre Schools reach over 1,000 children ages 3 -5 years the age that every child should be nurture to grow to their fullest. Instructor are selected from within the communities to ensure the active participation of the community in the development process. Gali Pre School develops a culture of education to children among the parents by ensuring that after attaining 5 years of age every child is enrolled in school.



### CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER (CDC)

As Asha Deep Foundation has always enlightened its concern in the holistic development of children, Therefore the Child Development Center has been running with aim dedicated for the education of children from rag picking community of Delhi-NCR and with a objective to prepare the children for main stream education.



### SENSITIZATION ON CHILD RIGHTS (UNCRC), J J & POCSO ACT

This programme aims to provide Child Protection and POCSO Act training to different stakeholders, children, community people and service providers such as CWC, Police Personnel, Doctors, Teachers, AWW/Frontline Health workers, Media Personnel, Childline/NGOs, Child Protection Communities, leaders, etc so that children are saved from Child Sexual Abuse.



### PSYCHOLOGICAL CARE : GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING

Psychological care is instrumental in the positive development of all individuals. People living in squalor conditions with lack of education and opportunity are likely to acquire psychological disorders. Therefore our team of counselors is diligent in analyzing the behavior of the children to ensure they don't fall victims to this crisis. The counselors are available daily to the children and families offering guidance, advice or to simply be a friend to those in need. This helps the children and community to understand the value of life and live with a better perspective.



### COMMUNITY HEALTH

Asha Deep Foundation lays immense emphasis on provision of health to the community and hence community health programme that provides access to health care services comprising of General OPD services for consultation and treatment of patients, Widespread awareness and Conduction of health camps regularly providing curative and preventive healthcare to the beneficiaries.



### RESPONSE TO COVID19 AND YOUTH EMPLOYABILITY PROGRAMMES

For the families having no ration card and are deprived of services provided by the Government, the programme helps part of population comprising of migrants/Daily wage earners/widows/ PWDs etc. The essential food kits were distributed as part of COVID recovery and providing mass awareness among the people on precautionary methods. Apart from ration distribution, this programme deals in enhancing the LifeSkills of an young people who are unemployed, facilitate employment for them and support them continuously for next one year through emotional support and counseling.
